The basis of the valuation of assets in a parish council's asset register is historic value i.e. the purchase price of the asset. Where that is not known, an insurance or replacement value can be used. There is no depreciation in a parish council's asset register - where an historic asset value has been identified, it always stays at that value in the register. Assets that do not have a resale value are referred to as 'community assets' and are consistently valued at £1 and gifted assets are valued at the nominal £1'

Bishopthorpe Parish Council has always valued its assets at £1 according to National Association of Local councils advice and will continue this practice going forward.
